

TASTING NOTE

2015 OAKDENE SHIRAZ



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Appearance

Deep garnet in colour.

Bouquet

Spicey and floral with lifted blackberry, cherry fruits, white pepper and clove.

Palate

The palate is dominated by dark red fruits and spice (clove/white pepper) leading to a soft, medium bodied mid- palate fine tannin and balanced acidity.

Conclusion

Drink now or over the next 2 to 8 years.

Technical Analysis Vineyard Location

Drysdale, Bellarine Peninsula, Geelong, Victoria, Australia

Climate

Maritime climate moderated by Bass Strait to the south, the Rip at Port Phillip Heads to the east, Swan Bay and Port Phillip bay to the North, and the Barwon River to the west.

Soils

Moderate draining loam over a clay loam subsoil

Trellis style

Vertical shoot positioning (VSP)

Clones Vines Planted

Yield Case Production

2.1 tonnes per acre 503 cases

Fermentation

Shiraz was destemmed, and then fermented in small open vats. Pressed to barrel for malolactic fermentation, and matured in French oak barriques (10% new) for 11 months, then bottled in July 2016.
