2021 OAKDENE 'LIZ'S' CHARDONNAY



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Appearance

Pale straw with a green hue.

Bouquet

Complex bouquet, with notes of dried apple, peach, and lemon citrus with barrel ferment characters.

Palate

Bright and vibrant, with a generous core of briny acidity and citrus crunch. Stone fruit, oatmeal and lemon curd filling the palate, with toasty oak and cedar notes contributing texture and balance.

Conclusion

Enjoy now with food or cellar for 4 to 8 years.

Maritime climate moderated by Bass Strait to the south, the Rip at Port Phillip Heads to the east, Swan Bay and Port Phillip bay to the North, and the Barwon River to the west.

Fermentation

Hand harvested Chardonnay was pressed and transferred to barrel for fermentation using wild yeast. Post ferment lees stirring was conducted on a fortnightly basis. The wine underwent partial (10%) malolactic fermentation, and was matured in French oak barriques (30% new) for 12 months prior to bottling in February 2022.
